



## Program Summary

ADAMM's TechTrain is a five class automotive technician training program taught at MATC north and south campuses. All classes are taught evenings in 15 week semesters spring and fall. TechTrain I (BMT) is taught classroom style with demonstration and interaction, covering all aspects of automotive repair. The four advanced classes concentrate on specific areas of the automobile and are hands-on lab classes focusing on diagnostic and problem solving skills.

Classes offered are:

- TT I Basic Mechanical Techniques
- TT II Automotive Electrical
- TT III Automotive Driveline
- TT IV Automotive Chassis & Air Conditioning
- TT V Automotive Engines & Emissions

The upcoming fall session begins September 2nd. Basic Mechanical Techniques and the advanced class, Automotive Electronics, will both be offered on Tuesday or Thursday evenings at MATC Mequon and Oak Creek locations.

TechTrain is a non-degree certificate program offered by ADAMM at MATC.

Registration is by appointment through ADAMM only. An interview and placement test is required to determine which class you will be assigned. There is a one time \$75.00 non-refundable Registration Fee that also covers all text books and materials. Tuition is \$250 per class.
