



## Program Summary

ADAMM's TechTrain is a five class automotive technician training program taught at MATC north and south campuses. All classes are taught evenings in 15 week semesters spring and fall. TechTrain I (BMT) is taught classroom style with demonstration and interaction, covering all aspects of automotive repair. The four advanced classes concentrate on specific areas of the automobile and are hands-on lab classes focusing on diagnostic and problem solving skills.

Classes offered are:

- TT I Basic Mechanical Techniques
- TT II Automotive Electrical
- TT III Automotive Driveline
- TT IV Automotive Chassis & Air Conditioning
- TT V Automotive Engines & Emissions

The upcoming spring session begins January 28, 2010. The initial class, Basic Mechanical Techniques and the advanced class, Automotive Engines and Emissions, will both be offered on Tuesday or Thursday evenings at MATC Mequon and Oak Creek locations.

TechTrain is a non-degree certificate program offered by ADAMM at MATC.

Registration is by appointment through ADAMM only and includes an interview by phone or in person. There is a one time \$60.00 non-refundable registration fee. Tuition is \$250 per class including all text and materials.
